Washington D.C., May 25, 2017: Space Trust, a non-partisan and non-profit initiative presented an innovative forum on Capitol Hill, "ZeroG [0G] Summit, Space Diplomacy in the Age of NewSpace" which featured <u>Congressman Jim Bridenstine</u>, US Representative for Oklahoma's First Congressional District, as the keynote speaker and Ms. Simonetta Di Pippo, Director of the <u>United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs</u> (UNOOSA) in Vienna, as the Guest of Honor.

The event on the Hill was a precursor to the annual 0G Summits on Earth which will be launched in September 2017, on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly in New York, to engage world leaders, peace makers, space actors, civil society and youth to find innovative solutions for a peaceful world. Together, these efforts are strategically aligned toward "0G Summit 2030"—the First Peace Summit in Orbit—in support of the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and more specifically, the work of the United Nations "Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space" (COPUOS).

UNOOSA is committed to working with partners around the world to promote and facilitate space to solve humankind's greatest challenges, and I appreciate Space Trust's dedication to this work. Our age of NewSpace opens the final frontier to all sectors and to the possibility of commercially viable private space stations and space habitats in Low Earth Orbit and beyond, which will serve as a realistic platform for 0G Summit 2030.

The goals of the Space Trust and the ZeroG Summit will help create a path to accelerate the good work being done and provide even more opportunities for significant positive global change."
